- b Touch the words "Shutdown Machine?"
- c Enter 6 4 6 4 7 2 2 5
- d Touch "Date and Time".
- e Touch the year and touch " " to change to 1 year behind and touch check mark to confirm.
- f Machine will shut off itself.
- g Toggle rear power switch OFF and back ON.
- h Press front ON/OFF Switch (under the display) for HOME page.
- Connect to WIFI and perform software and firmware update.

#### **USB** Setup

- a. Select a USB with 16GB or less.
- b. Format the USB to FAT32 & rename to "MYPROGRAMS".

#### **Exporting/Saving Data to USB Drive**

- a. The USB port is under the left side of the display.
- b. Touch "GEAR" icon, than touch the "GREEN LOCK" icon.
- c. Touch DOWN arrow twice, than touch "Export" to save data to USB.
- d. Touch each category to save, than touch the CHECK MARK to execute.
- e. Touch UP arrow to confirm, than touch LEFT arrow 4 times to return Home.

#### **WIFI Access**

HAVE WIFI PASSWORD READY BEFORE PROCEEDING.

MACHINE MAY HAVE TO MOVE LOCATION FOR STRONGER WIFI SIGNAL OR USE CELL PHONE AS HOT SPOT.

a. Touch "GEAR" icon.

NOTE :

- b. Touch "BLUE WIFI" icon.
- c. Touch WIFI access point, enter password and touch CHECK MARK.
- d. Touch top LEFT arrow to go back to "GEAR" icon screen.

#### Software Update - Current available version 1.5.3

- a. In "GEAR" icon screen touch UP arrow to locate "BLUE UPDATE" icon.
- b. Touch "BLUE UPDATE" icon, machine will scan for update.
- c. To update touch "GREEN UPDATE" arrow.
- d. Allow 1 to 10 minute for update and reset to Home page.

TIME IS DEPENDENT ON UPDATE SIZE AND WIFI QUALITY.

UPDATE ABORTED means WiFi signal is not strong enough.

Move machine closer to WiFi access point (router).

Repeat steps above.

NOTE: If no update found, BACK arrow to HOME proceed to step e.

- e. Toggle main power switch OFF, wait 30 seconds & toggle back ON.
- f. IMPORTANT: Proceed to Firmware Update.

#### Firmware Update - Current available version 4.17

- a. Switch on machine to HOME page
- b. Touch "GEAR" icon, than touch the "GREEN LOCK" icon.
- c. Scroll down until "Firmware Update".
- d. Touch "Firmware update" and wait for firmware number to appear. (Note the firmware update number.)
- e. Touch "GREEN UPDATE" icon.
- f. Allow 1 minute for update and reset to Home page.
- g. Toggle main power switch OFF, wait 30 seconds & toggle back ON.
- h. Repeat step a through d to confirm update 4.17.
